History

The Helen Stokes Memorial Scholarship Fund was started in 1956 as a tribute to the South Carolina State President, Helen Stokes. Mrs. Stokes suggested to the state board that instead of a departing president's gift, a scholarship fund be established to encourage graduating South Carolina high school seniors to enter the teaching profession. Her husband, Dr. J. Howard Stokes Sr. offered to match the money contributed by the board and the fund was established.

Over the past 50 years, the fund has sponsored many South Carolina students by awarding them scholarships to help with the cost of their education. The scholarship has been used to assist students obtain post-secondary education goals in their desired discipline. The fund is financed through Honorary Life Membership awards, the SCPTA Spirit of PTA Award, local unit contributions, memorials, sponsorship of applicants, and corporate gifts. The number of scholarships is directly related to the amount of money taken into the fund each year. A committee from the SCPTA board of directors is responsible for the administrative duties of the fund and awarding of scholarships.

Eligibility

- Scholarship applicant must be a senior at a South Carolina high school.
- Applicant must be a South Carolina resident for at least one (1) year.
- Applicants will be judged on the following criteria: PTA involvement and membership, academic record (including ACT/WorkKeys scores), extracurricular activities, letters of recommendation, and an essay.
- Recipients must plan to attend an accredited college as determined by US Department of Education in South Carolina.
- Scholarship is for one (1) year, payable Fall Semester only.
- The Helen Stokes Scholarship committee shall review all applications and shall have full authority to grant scholarships. All decisions of the committee are final.
- All applications **must** contain a signature of sponsorship from a local PTA/PTSA in good standing with the SCPTA. (If an applicant attends a high school without a PTA, the student may be sponsored by any elementary, middle, or junior high school, which is considered a feeder school of that high school.)

- The PTA/PTSA recommending the applicant must contribute at least \$25.00 per applicant before March 1 of the current year to the Helen Stokes Memorial Fund. PTA/PTSA units must also be in good standing with the SCPTA to sponsor a student. Note: Honorary Life Membership award contributions may be used toward sponsoring a student or students (2 per Life Memberships).

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Helen Stokes Memorial Scholarship Application

To be considered for the Helen Stokes Scholarship the following items must be submitted together in one envelope:

1. Complete application form
2. Transcript of grades
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - a. 1 academic letter of recommendation (principal, teacher, counselor)
 - b. 1 character letter of recommendation (pastor, employer, etc.)
4. Signature of sponsorship from a SC PTA/PTSA unit in good standing with the SCPTA, and \$25.00 contribution to the Helen Stokes Scholarship fund. This can be in the form of a Life Membership.
5. Signature of PTA/PTSA president and/or treasurer

6. Essay- Why Do Students and Schools Need PTA? (400-700 words)

7. **Any incomplete application will be disqualified.**
